Theme

Caring for our Earth

This week is all about caring for our Earth in preparation for Earth Day next week. We will learn about the importance recycling and putting our litter where it belongs. We will also continue to watch our seeds and plants grow. We depend on plants for our oxygen supply. We need clean air and clean water to survive.

Art

Paper pulp art- We used colored paper pulp to mold unique paper projects.
Dipping in Dye- We will watch the colors blend on our paper towel as we dip it into different colored water.

Math/ Science

Colored Celery- We will see how water moves through a plant as we see the colored water travel up the celery stalk, all the way up to the leaves.
